**MENU** We have designed our menu to feature a variety of delicious and nutritious lunch options with fresh, seasonal ingredients. Our menu features a variety of individually packaged & labelled cold lunch entrees, A La Carte items, staff lunches & beverages. Our lunches are nutrient dense, colorful, and fun! When we started our program we worked with Dietitian and co-owner of Feeding Littles Megan McNamee MPH, RDN to develop our menu variety and selections. **INGREDIENTS** We source **100% Organic**: Produce, Milk, Eggs, Yogurt, Cottage Cheese, String Cheese, White Cheddar, Whole Grain Bread, Black beans, Chickpeas, Corn, Agave, Quinoa & Rice. Our sauces and dips are Organic and made in-house. Our baked goods, buns, pita and tortillas are **Whole Grain** or **Whole Wheat** and **Non-GMO**. We source Local **Grass-fed**, Grass-finished, **Free-Range** Beef and **All-Natural** Poultry raised without hormones or antibiotics ever. Our deli meat & pepperoni is **Nitrate Free** and 6 ingredients or less. **Our lunches do not contain added sugar or artificial food coloring.**

**MEAL SIZES** The difference in our Petite, Preschool & Primary meals are mainly the portion and packaging sizes. We list age recommendations for each meal option based on the portions and age appropriate sides. Our Primary meals may have whole grapes, house-made tortilla chips, lettuce or whole baby carrots and our Petite & Primary Meals do not as they may pose a choking risk to children under 5 years of age. When preparing our Petite & Preschool meals we offer foods in various safe sizes to allow children to practice eating all appropriate textures and types of foods. We are very careful to not offer any choking hazards.

**ALLERGIES** We are happy to accommodate most allergies. After you've created your online profile, please email us so we may update our notes with your child's specific dietary needs. We have several measures in place to limit the risk of cross-contamination when preparing allergy meals; however, we cannot ensure that there is no risk. We cannot be held liable should an allergic reaction occur. *Our meals do not contain nuts or shellfish; however, we do operate out of a kitchen that handles nuts, nut products and shellfish. Our kitchen and some of our lunch options contain Egg, Wheat, Gluten, Dairy, Soy, Corn & Salmon.*

**PACKAGING** We are proud to use eco-friendly packaging. Our containers are either plant based or 100% recyclable. Our lunches are individually packaged and labelled with your child's name, class and dietary restrictions. Beginning this 2020/2021 school year, each lunch will contain individually wrapped utensils inside the meal box to eliminate additional exposure.

**CANCELLATION POLICY** Our order and cancellation deadlines are 48 hours prior. You may revise or cancel your order with 48 hours' notice in our online system. Meal cancellations will be posted to your lunch account as credit towards future orders. If the absence is unexpected you may be able to pick-up your child's lunch from school, depending on your school's food storage policy and refrigeration.
